It was fairly easy to make counterfeit money before 1860 because the designs were simple and printed on only one side. To start, designs on bills were simple and easily reproduced. The text states: "The designs on them were fairly simple." Next, paper money was only printed on a single side. The text also states: "Most of the colonial bills were small and printed on only one side. In conclusion, simple designs + single printed sided bills made it easy for counterfeiters to make money."
